











TRIMPAL INSTRUCTION MANUAL

<p>Step 1: Verify that the timer, located on the back panel, is in the off position.</p>	
<p>Step 2: Plug in the power cord.</p>	
<p>Step 3: Remove the safety shield and basket lid.</p>	
<p>Step 4: Pull the position pin and rotate the barrel to the face up position.</p>	
<p>Step 5: Fill the basket ¾ of the way full (product must be properly dried).*</p>	

<p>Step 6: Replace the basket lid and safety shield.</p>	
<p>*If product is sticking to the basket it is not dry enough to trim, stems must snap not bend.</p>	
<p>Step 7: Rotate the barrel back to its horizontal position and insert the position pin.</p>	
<p>Step 8: Spray Olive Oil through oiling hole. **</p>	
<p>Step 9: Place a size appropriate container below TrimPal in a way in which the debris being removed from product will fall into it.</p>	
<p>Step 10: Set the timer to preferred time (5-10 minute intervals recommended). TrimPal will automatically shut off after time is up.</p>	

Step 11:

After product is manicured to a suitable degree remove safety shield and basket lid.



Step 12:

Remove position pin and dump final product into chosen container. Repeat steps 4 thru 12
